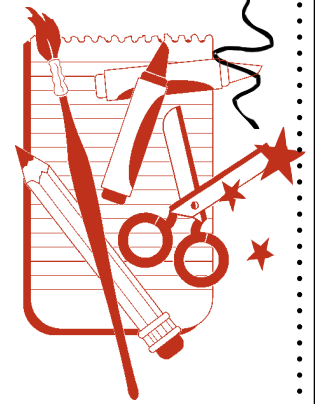

Donors can drop off general school supplies (see list at right) or adopt a student by filling a backpack with supplies from individual school lists found on the district website www.isd12.org (label with school and grade). Cash and gift card donations are also accepted.

Collection points for community donations are Our Savior's Lutheran Church, Festival Foods, Tree of Life Church, Centennial Community Services and the Centennial Square Night to Unite campaign (formerly National Night Out, August 3).

How can you help?
